

CUSTOMER CODE OF PRACTICE FOR MANAGING WASTE STREAMS

PESTICIDE CANS must be triple rinsed and collected in the bag provided.

FOILS AND CAPS must be removed and placed in the 50-litre bag provided. This bag should be tied and placed inside the larger bag with the pesticide cans.

SLUG PELLET BAGS AND DRY FLOWABLE PESTICIDE BAGS should be bundled together with paper bags being put first into a 200 litre bag then placed in the bag with the pesticide cans.

On collection or delivery to the hub, all **BAGS OF PESTICIDE CANS** should be tied and marked with the contract number in black marker pen.

SEED BAGS AND FERTILISER BAGS should be placed inside one another or tied in manageable bundles.

CARDBOARD should be flat packed and either stacked and tied in bundles or placed in a fertiliser or seed bag.

SILAGE WRAP AND CROP COVER needs to be dry and free from as much contamination as possible and put in the appropriate bag provided.

POLYTHENE SHEET AND SHRINK WRAP should be rolled up, put into the bags provided and tied off.

STRING OR NET WRAP should be placed into the bag provided and tied off.

OIL FILTERS, AIR FILTERS AND FUEL FILTERS can be put into the resealable drum provided or smaller quantities can be placed in a 50-litre bag and tied to prevent leakage.

GREASE GUN CARTRIDGES AND OILY RAGS can be put together into the resealable drum provided or smaller quantities can be placed in a 50-litre bag and tied.

SPENT SHOTGUN CARTRIDGES can be brought into us for recycling in 50 litre or 200 litre bags.

OTHER RECYCLABLE WASTE can often be accommodated, please ask before co-mingling with any of the other waste streams above.
